RULES AND INFORMATION: The USGA Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, and all Local Rules established specifically for the Championship will be in effect. Players wanting the MGA Rules Card may find it on the MGA web site – www.mngolf.org - under the Tournament & Rules Section. Local Rules will be distributed daily to the players at their respective starting holes.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: The Bridges Golf Club is a public facility with practice rounds available by tee time arrangement in advance. Please call The Bridges Golf Shop at (507) 454-3535 to schedule a practice round and identify yourself as a Minnesota State Junior Boys participant. Practice round rates are \$7.50, 9 holes or \$13.50 walking, 18 holes or \$20 riding (must have a valid driver's license to rent/drive the golf car) either 9 or 18 holes. Adults may play with the junior at the twilight rate.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: Players are permitted to use distance measuring devices.

PACE OF PLAY: The official MGA Pace of Play Policy will be in effect and is posted on our website.

PLAYER CONDUCT: The Rules Officials will strongly enforce a code of conduct for all players. Unbecoming conduct includes, but is not limited to the following:

- (1) Any use of loud profanity reported and collaborated will be penalized.
- (2) Any club throwing, club slamming or other disruptive behavior will be penalized.

Penalty for unbecoming conduct – **two strokes**,

Penalty for repeated offense or a serious breach of player conduct - **disqualification**.

CLOSEST-TO-PIN CONTEST: There will be a Closest-to-Pin Contest on the driving range from approximately 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Monday. All players are encouraged to participate! An award will be presented to the winner during the cookout on Monday night at The Bridges GC.

PUTTING CONTEST/COOKOUT: There will be a cookout open to everyone on Monday from approximately 5:00 PM through 8:00 PM. This cookout will serve as the player's meal, provided by the MGA, on Monday. Parents and any other spectators are welcome to join as well and are expected to pay the management at the facility for their meal. During the cookout, there will be a putting contest on The Bridges GC practice putting green and a closest-to-pin contest on the driving range. All players are encouraged to participate! Once all play has concluded, we will announce the pairings for Tuesday and hand out awards to the winner of the Closest-to-Pin Contest and the Putting Contest.

PRACTICE RANGE: The practice range will be open at 6:30 AM both days. Range balls will be provided.

PLAYER MEALS: The MGA will provide each competitor with a meal at the club both Monday and Tuesday. **Monday's** meal will be available during a cookout at the club from approximately 5:00 PM through 8:00 PM. **Tuesday's** meal will be provided to all competitors from approximately 11:00 AM through 2:30 PM. Players with morning starting times will eat after their round and players with afternoon starting times will need to eat prior to their rounds.

DRESS CODE: ***The dress code will be strictly enforced.*** For all MGA competitions, players must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All players are required to wear shirts with collars and sleeves, and either golf slacks or Bermuda shorts, which measure no higher than 2 inches above their knees. Examples of attire NOT ACCEPTABLE attire includes the following: short shorts, athletic shorts, tennis shorts, cut-offs, jeans, jean shorts, tank tops, t-shirts, sweat pants. The committee in charge shall decide whether this requirement has been met and will withdraw the entry of the player who does not comply.

FINE DESIGNS: The company has worked with The Bridges to develop a logo for the 91st Minnesota State Junior Boys Championship. They will have t-shirts, sweatshirts and sweatpants available for purchase.

CADDIES AND CARTS: The Bridges GC *does not* have caddies available. Players may walk carrying their own clubs or use a pull cart. Also, players are permitted the use of a caddie; however, a player *may not use a parent, step-parent, or guardian* as a caddie. (This policy is used by the USGA in the US Junior Amateur Championship)

AWARDS PRESENTATION: Immediately after the conclusion of the play Tuesday, there will be an awards presentation.

ETIQUETTE: Please be courteous to your fellow-competitors and the golf course by replacing divots, fixing ball marks, and raking bunkers.
