- Bunker Rule - If a ball lies in a damaged area in a bunker (regardless of cause other than caused by the ball entering the bunker), relief may be taken without penalty in accordance with Rule 16.1c as long as relief is taken within the bunker and within one club length of the nearest point of complete relief, no nearer the hole and the ball must be dropped. This applies to lie of ball and area of intended swing only. NOTE: In the unlikely event there is no relief available without going closer to the hole, the

NO PLAY ZONE: All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds - mandatory relief

OBSTRUCTIONS: All artificially surfaced roads and paths including gravel and rock surfaced paths and roads and reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial borders. Any vertical panel installed to prevent flooding is an **immovable obstruction** from which free relief is available as long as the ball lies OUTSIDE the penalty area. If the ball is IN the penalty area, the player is not entitled to free relief. Player must play the ball as it lies or take relief from the penalty area.

OVERHEAD POWER LINES (MODEL LOCAL RULE E-11): If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line in-bounds during the play of Hole #18, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made.
