TEES: All males will play from the **WHITE TEES** with an option to move to the **GOLD TEES**. All females will play from the **RED TEES**.

FORMAT: 18 holes Tuesday and Wednesday Best Ball Net Stableford Points of squad A and squad B added together for each hole. The team with the lowest 36-hole score will be the champion.

PLAYOFF: Any ties for prizes, including for the Championship, will be decided by a scorecard playoff using the USGA recommended procedure found in the Rules of Golf book. Round 2 stableford points will be used first. In the event there remains a tie after Round 2 stableford points are used, Round 1 stableford points will be used. In the unlikely event teams remain tied the tie will be broken by lot.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Defined by white lines.

ONE-BALL RULE: is **NOT** in effect for this championship.

PROHIBITION TO PRACTICE PUTTING: Is NOT in effect for this Championship.

OUT OF BOUNDS: There are no boundaries on this course.

PENALTY AREAS: Penalty Areas are defined by stakes and/or lines. Including all areas of dense trees, brush or long grass are to be played as a red penalty area and the edge of the penalty area is the mow (cut) line between the rough and long grass even when not marked.

NO PLAY ZONES: There are environmentally sensitive areas found on holes #4, 5, 6, & 13. Play from these areas is strictly prohibited by federal law and the Rules of Golf. Penalty for breach of rule: **Two Strokes.**

PACE OF PLAY: MGA Pace of Play Policy made available to all players will be in effect.

ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES: The use of rangefinders and GPS is ALLOWED – to measure distance only.
