Local Rules and Information Sheet

TEE MARKERS: USGA BLUE

FORMAT: 18-holes, stroke play

QUALIFIERS: 5 ALTERNATES: 2

TIES & PLAYOFFS: In the event of a tie for the final qualifying spot and/or any alternate position, a hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted immediately following play.

EVACUATION PLAN: In the event play is suspended for a dangerous situation (lightning), players are to return to the Clubhouse. The signal for a suspension due to a dangerous situation is two (2) prolonged horn blasts.

ELECTRONIC SCORING: Per the information posted on the Qualifying webpage, the official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the *Golf Genius App.* Players should report to the Scoring Area for verification of scores prior to certifying the scores through the app.

Rules are governed by the Rules of Golf, USGA Terms of Competition, Notice to Competitors, Memo to Players and the following local rules. Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local card.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Boundaries are defined by **white stakes** (5E), the **chain link fences** (holes 4E, 8E, 9E, 6W, 7W) as well as the **inside edge of concrete curbing** bordering 9E.

PENALTY AREAS: When both are present, stakes <u>identify</u> and lines <u>define</u> a Penalty Area. (**NOTE:** The Opposite Margin" relief option <u>is not</u> in effect for the Red Penalty Area on 7W).

DROPPING AREAS: Hole #7W for a ball in the penalty area as an additional option. #9W for a ball with interference from the clubhouse.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas circled by white lines. In addition, all cultivated flower and shrubbery beds are *NO PLAY ZONES.*

OBSTRUCTIONS: The Maintenance Area adjacent to Holes 6E & 9E, all artificially surfaced cart paths (including surfaced with gravel and wood chips), worn extensions of such, wood curbing along the paths, sprinkler heads, control boxes, and shelters are Immovable Obstructions. (NOTE: Unsurfaced and worn "paths" used by maintenance vehicles <u>are not</u> immovable obstructions.)

ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES: Per the USGA Terms of Competition, distance measuring devices <u>ARE</u> <u>permitted</u>. However, information gained from their use must be limited to DISTANCE ONLY.

PACE OF PLAY/UNREASONABLE DELAY (RULE 5.6): Players are expected to play without delay, and groups are expected to remain in position with the group immediately in front of it. Timing sheets for each round showing the time by when each hole must be completed are posted on the Qualifying webpage. Groups who fall out of position are subject to monitoring and timing by a rules official. Players are expected to play a stroke within 40 seconds of when it is their time to play. Players who receive a bad time will be warned. Players who receive multiple bad times are subject to penalty. The expected pace of play is **4:37** for 18 holes. Penalty for Breach of Rule 5.6a: **First breach:** *Warning;* **Second breach:** *One penalty stroke;* **Third breach:** *Two penalty strokes;* **Fourth breach:** *DISQUALIFICATION.*

BALL PLAYED FROM OUTSIDE RELIEF AREA WHEN TAKING BACK-ON-THE-LINE RELIEF: Model Local Rule E-12 is in effect.

USGA GROOVES POLICY: Model Local Rule G-2 is in effect. "**ONE-BALL" CONDITION:** Model Local Rule G-4 is in effect. REPLACEMENT OF BROKEN OR SIGNIFICANTLY DAMAGED CLUB: Model Local Rule G-9 is in effect.
