Local Rules and Information Sheet



RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, Notice to Competitors, Entry Blank and the following Local Rules. NOTE: Disregard all Local Rules printed on the local scorecard.

TEES: Championship = **MGA GREEN tee markers.**

FORMAT: Championship = 54 holes, stroke play
(This event may be shortened due to extenuating circumstances.)

POSTING OF SCORES: The MGA will be posting scores to GHIN for handicap purposes.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Boundaries are defined by the asphalt edge of the road behind the 2nd and 4th greens.

PENALTY AREAS: When stakes and lines are used to mark a penalty area, the stakes *identify* while the lines *define* the edge.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are considered ground under repair:

- (1) All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – **No Play Zones**
- (2) Sod Seams (Model Local Rule F-7) – relief for lie of ball and area of intended swing only

DROPPING ZONE: A Dropping Zone has been provided as an additional relief option for a ball in the Penalty Area on Hole #15.

INTEGRAL OBJECTS: The barn on Hole #1 is an Integral Object.

PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play policy is in effect during the Championship. Please make sure you maintain position on the course at all times.

REST AREAS: Are located at the 4th, 6th and 14th tees.

BOTTLED WATER: Will be available at the 1st, 7th, 10th and 15th tees.

STARTING TIMES FOR WEDNESDAY: Due to the size of the field, all players will advance to the final round on Wednesday. The leaders will go at *9:30 am off #1 tee*, with the highest scoring players who make the cut going at *9:30 am off #10 tee*. Approximate time for the first groups will be approximately 7:30 am. Players will be notified by email and text of their starting time, hole and GGID.
