

2023 MGA WOMEN'S FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP

Faribault Golf Club, Faribault, MN Monday-Tuesday, July 31-August 1, 2023 Local Rules and Information Sheet



RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, Notice to Competitors, Entry Blank and the following Local Rules. NOTE: Disregard all Local Rules printed on the local scorecard.

TEES: Championship = MGA BLUE tee markers.

Flight = MGA WHITE tee markers

FORMAT: Championship = 36 holes, stroke play

(This event may be shortened due to extenuating circumstances.)

DECISIONS ON TIES: In the event of a tie for the Championship flight, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff starting on Hole #10, and if still tied, followed by 11, and then 9 until a winner is determined. The First Flight will be decided according to the method outlined in the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf (pgs 402-404).

POSTING OF SCORES: The MGA *will NOT be* posting scores to GHIN for handicap purposes.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Boundaries are defined by white stakes, lines and the inside edge of curbing on Hole #18.

PENALTY AREAS: When stakes and lines are used to mark a penalty area, the stakes *identify* while the lines *define* the edge.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are considered ground under repair:

- (1) Practice bunker to the right of #9
- (2) The Chipping Green to the right of Hole #9 is a "wrong green."

PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play policy is in effect during the Championship. Please make sure you maintain position on the course at all times.

REST AREAS: Are located between the 6th & 7th tees near the 11th and 13th greens.

DRINKING WATER: Will be available at holes 4, 6, 8, 13 & 16 as well as #1 & 10 tees.
