ELECTRONIC SCORING:

The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the Golf Genius Mobile App. Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational

information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. After completing your final hole, all players and their markers should go to the Scoring Area immediately

to certify their scores.

> **OUT OF** Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stakes including in-course OB for hole #2 **BOUNDS:**

only (defined by stakes) and white stakes along holes #1, 2, 3 & 18. Inside pavement edges of public roads along #4, 8, 14, 15, 16, and driveway/parking lot area. White stakes/lines surrounding

the driving range.

> **PENALTY** Penalty Areas are defined by either **RED** stakes and/or lines.

the mow line.

Local Rule E-1.1 Dropping Zones have been provided as additional relief options as follows: Hole #17: For a ball ending in the penalty area behind the green. (painted right of the green).

In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are *ground under repair:* Model Local Rule F-7 – Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas – lie of ball & area of

NO PLAY ZONE: All cultivated flower & shrubbery beds – *mandatory relief*

reasonable extensions thereof including their artificial borders. Buildings, sprinkler heads, vehicles, stakes, player equipment, signposts, benches, walls, boulders and fences (not marking boundaries)

are either Moveable or Immovable Obstructions.
