When both stakes and lines are used to mark a Penalty Area, the stakes <i>identify</i> while the lines <i>define</i> the Penalty Area. All long grass areas that are not mowed, are being played as a penalty area. The mow line defines the penalty area. If no stakes identify the area, play as a red penalty area.
