- TEES:** All play will be from the **WHITE** tees (Approx: 6,269 yards)
- SPOTS:** Qualifiers: **21**
- TIES:** In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following the completion of play. Alternates will be decided by the qualifying format found on the MGA website Senior Amateur Championship landing page.
- RULES:** The *Rules of Golf*, the *MGA Terms of Competition*, *Pace of Play Policy* and the following local rules govern play. NOTE: Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.
- FORMAT:** Two 9-hole rounds, stroke play. The MGA reserves the right to shorten the qualifying to 9 holes if bad weather does not allow the full 18 holes to be completed. If this happens, results will be based on 9-hole scores with the available spots divided accordingly.
- ELECTRONIC SCORING:** The official method of scoring will be electronic by use of the **Golf Genius Mobile App**. Paper scorecards will not be provided to players. Players should review the printed and video educational information posted on the qualifying webpage to prepare in advance for this process. Also, players should make sure their mobile devices are fully charged prior to beginning play. **After completing your final hole, please return to the scoring area to certify as the marker and as the player.**
- ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES:** Per the USGA Terms of Competition, distance measuring devices **ARE permitted**. However, information gained from their use must be limited to DISTANCE ONLY.
- OUT OF BOUNDS:** Course boundaries are defined by the following: White stake or lines and property fences. In the absence of white stakes, the inside edge of Pavement/Curbing for roads or parking lot bordering the course.
- PENALTY AREAS:** Penalty Areas are defined by **YELLOW OR RED** stakes and/or lines. When both stakes and lines are used to mark, the stakes *identify* the penalty area, while the lines *define* the penalty area.
- GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following areas are ground under repair:
(1) Brush and Sand Piles right of #8
(2) Turf nurseries adjacent to Holes #2, 4, 5, 8 – (**MANDATORY RELIEF**)
(3) Cultivated flower & shrubbery beds (**MANDATORY RELIEF**)
(4) **Model Local Rule F-7** – Ball in sod seams of newly sodded areas – lie of ball & area of intended swing only.
- NO PLAY ZONE:** In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following define GUR:
- SCREEN #7 TEE:** There is no "line of flight" relief from the screen protecting #7 teeing ground.
- DROP ZONES:** Disregard any and all "Drop Zones."
- RULES COMMITTEE:** MGA Site Captain and any other MGA committee person.
