

98th MINNESOTA STATE JUNIOR BOYS' CHAMPIONSHIP

Crow River Golf Club, Hutchinson, MN Monday-Wednesday, June 24-26, 2024



Local Rules and Information Sheet

RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, MGA Model Local Rules, Notice to Competitors, Entry Blank, Pace of Play and the following local rules. *NOTE:* Disregard any and all local rules printed on the local scorecard.

TEES: All competitors will play from the **MGA TEE MARKERS** (Approx. 6,568 Yards, Par 71).

FORMAT: 54 Holes, stroke play, with the lowest scorer being declared the champion.

The Championship may be shortened, or a cut made if weather conditions do not allow for the entire Championship to be played. A cut to the low 24 players + ties will be made after the 2nd round for the 3rd round of play.

PLAYOFFS: A tie for the Championship will be decided by a playoff on the course immediately following completion of the final round. Holes: TBD. Any playoff for second or third place will end in a tie for trophies and awards.

PRACTICE PUTTING: Is **NOT** permitted on the putting green of the hole last played per MGA Policy. **Penalty:** Two strokes at the next hole.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to areas circled by white lines, the following are ground under repair:

- (1) All cultivated flower and shrubbery beds **no play zones.**
- (2) Areas with small white with green top stakes.

PENALTY AREAS: Are defined by either **Yellow** or **Red** lines and/or stakes. When stakes and lines are used to mark a penalty area, the stakes *identify* the hazard while the lines *define* the margin. If a portion of the penalty area is not marked by stakes or lines, the mow line will define the edge of the red penalty area.

NATIVE GRASS AREAS: Are treated as Red Penalty Areas and are identified by **Red** stakes and defined by the mow line

DROPPING ZONES: Local Rule E-1.1: There are no dropping zones in use for the championship.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Boundaries are defined and identified by white stakes and property fences and/or edge of payement of all public roads bordering the course define the boundaries.

PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play policy posted on the Championship webpage is in effect. Please make sure you maintain position with the group in front of you on the course at all times.

SCORING AREA: Official scoring will be done through the digital scorecard on the Golf Genius App. Please report to the Scoring Area immediately following play to confirm scores.

POSTING OF SCORES: The MGA $\underline{will\ be}$ posting scores to GHIN for handicap purposes.

RULES COMMITTEE: Bob Boldus (952/201-5670) and any MGA Rules Official.

STARTING TIMES: 1st round starting times are decided by random draw. 2nd round starting times will be decided in equity based on first round starting times. i.e., morning day 1 to afternoon day 2, afternoon day 1 to morning day 2. Play will be starting on holes #1 and #10. 3rd round starting times will be decided by the total of the first and second round scores, with the leaders going out last. All play will start on hole #1 for the 3rd round.

WEDNESDAY STARTING TIMES: Starting times will be announced approximately an hour after the play is concluded for day two. Please check www.mngolf.org for Day Three's starting times. A link will be placed on the Championship webpage to the Starting Times for Day Three. A text message and email will be sent out to participants. Please check with event staff to ensure correct information is included in your event profile.
