



## MGA WOMEN'S AMATEUR SENIOR FOUR-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP Burl Oaks Golf Club

Monday - Tuesday, June 3-4, 2024 Local Rules and Information Sheet

**FORMAT**: Format is 36-holes, Four-Ball stroke play without handicap to be conducted over two days with no cut. The field was flighted after the close of entries, and teams assigned to a flight based on the lowest individual Handicap Index® (as of the day after entries close) of the two team members.

**RULES OF PLAY**: Play is governed by the Rules of Golf, MGA Terms of Competition, Notice to Competitors, Championship Webpage and the following local rules. NOTE: Disregard all local rules printed on the local scorecard.

## **TEES MARKERS:**

The **CHAMPIONSHIP FLIGHT** will play from the **WHITE MGA** tee markers. Other **FLIGHTS** will play from the **RED MGA** tee markers.

**OUT OF BOUNDS**: Defined by fences, white stakes, and white lines.

**PENALTY AREAS**: All penalty areas are red. When stakes and lines are used to mark penalty areas, the stakes *identify* the penalty areas, while the lines *define* them.

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR**: Defined by white lines.

**NO PLAY ZONES:** All cultivated flower and shrubbery beds are **No Play Zones.** Players must not play from them.

**OBSTRUCTIONS**: If a ball strikes an elevated power line on hole #1, the stroke must be canceled and replayed, without penalty (see Model Local Rule E-11). Rocks adjacent/lining cart paths are considered part of the cart path. The poles on the left side of hole #1 are considered an integral object—**No Relief**.

**PACE OF PLAY**: The MGA Pace of Play policy posted on the Championship webpage is in effect. Please make sure you always maintain position with the group in front of you on the course. Note: The Committee reserves the right at any time to monitor or time a group/match when it deems it necessary.

**DECISIONS ON TIES:** In the event of a tie for Championship flight, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off starting on #10 and continuing until a winner is determined. Any ties for prizes within flights will be settled as the USGA recommends. See page 403 of the "Official Guide to the Rules of Golf." If a tie remains, the winner will be determined by a coin flip.

**REST AREAS/WATER:** Rest areas are between the 6<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> holes and behind the 13<sup>th</sup> tee. There is drinking water on the golf course on the 3<sup>rd</sup> tee, 6<sup>th</sup> green, 9<sup>th</sup> tee, 13<sup>th</sup> tee and 15<sup>th</sup> tee in addition to the Clubhouse.
