

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- **CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT:** The Championship is a 36-hole stroke play event. Players will play 18 holes each day. The Champion will be the player with the lowest score in the Championship Flight.
- **DIVISIONS:** There will be two divisions: Master Division (65 & over who declare the Master Division) and Senior Division (everyone else). The Master will be played NET using full handicap. The flights within the Senior Division will play GROSS.
- **PLAY-OFF**: In the event of a tie for championship flight there will be a hole-by-hole play-off on a hole to be determined by the Committee. All other flights according to the USGA method of settling ties. See pages 402-404 of the "Official Guide to the Rules of Golf". If still tied, a coin flip.
- **PRACTICE ROUND** Practice rounds will be available. To schedule a practice round, call Eagle Creek Golf Club (320/235-1166) and identify yourself as a MGA Women's Senior Amateur contestant. The fee may be determined by the day and time you play.
- **REGISTRATION AREA:** A Registration Table will be setup prior to each round. Please be sure to check in each day.
- PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play Policy posted on the Championship homepage will be in effect.
- **STARTING TIMES**: There will be **no** change in starting times other than by decision of the Committee due to weather conditions. Tuesday starting times will be a 1:00 PM shotgun. Wednesday starting times will begin at 8:00 AM off #1/10.
- **PRACTICE RANGE:** Range balls will be provided on each day of the competition prior to play only. The range will open at least 60 minutes prior to play.
- **PLAYERS' DINNER / FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICE**: There will be a Players Dinner on Tuesday immediately following play. Guests are invited for \$35. Please notify the MGA staff in advance if you will be bringing a guest. Food and beverages are available at other times on a cash or charge basis.
- **POSTING SCORES**: All scores recorded in this competition will be posted to GHIN as tournament ("T") scores. Do **not** enter these scores yourself.
- **CADDIES AND CARTS**: You may use a caddie, cart, pull/push cart (including electric) or carry your own bag.
 - Cart rental rates are \$25 per person per day (shared cart). If you did not prepay for a cart in the registration process, you are responsible for paying for your cart in the Golf Shop prior to play each day.
- **FOOTWEAR POLICY**: As stated in the official entry form, the use of metal, traditionally-designed or ground piercing spikes are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition is **DISQUALIFICATION**.
- **PRIZES**: A trophy will be awarded to the Champion for their permanent possession. Merchandise prizes will be awarded as determined by the Tournament Committee.
