## **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

**LODGING:** No lodging has been arranged for the Championship.

**FORMAT:** All players entered in the Championship will play 36 holes stroke play over the two days Tuesday-Wednesday, August 27-28, at Chaska Town Course. The Champion will be the player with the lowest total score for 36 holes. A tie for the Championship will be played off immediately, hole by hole, until the winner is determined.

**CADDIES AND CARTS:** Caddies will be permitted as are carrying your own bag, the use of pull/push carts, including motorized, and motorized riding carts.

**RULES OF PLAY:** All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Terms of Competition, entry form, Pace of Play Policy and any Local Rules established and printed on the Hole Location/Local Rules Sheet.

**REGISTRATION:** Please check-in daily at the registration table. Please be at your starting tee immediately after the group in front of you has left the tee.

**ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES:** These devices are **permitted** in all MGA championship competitions; however, any function that measures more than point-to-point are not permitted. Use of such function is the **General Penalty** for the first offense and **disqualification** for the second.

pace of PLAY/UNREASONABLE DELAY (RULE 5.6): Players are expected to play without delay, and groups are expected to remain in position with the group immediately in front of it. Timing sheets for each round showing the time by when each hole must be completed are posted on the Championship webpage. Groups who fall out of position are subject to monitoring and timing by a Rules official. Players are expected to play a stroke within 40 seconds of when it is their time to play. Players who receive a bad time will be warned. Players who receive multiple bad times are subject to penalty. Penalty for Breach of Rule 5.6a: First breach: Warning; Second breach: One penalty stroke; Third breach: Two penalty strokes; Fourth breach: DISQUALIFICATION.

**STARTING TIMES:** There will be no change in starting times other than by decision of the Committee due to weather conditions. The starting times will be as follows:

**Tuesday:** Starting times will begin at 8:00 am from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee. **Wednesday:** Starting times will be from #1 beginning at 9:00 am.

**PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Practice rounds are available. To schedule, please call the course directly and identify yourself as an MGA Mid-Amateur contestant. Rate may vary according to day and time you choose to play or times may be restricted according to member play.

**PRACTICE RANGE:** The practice range at both clubs will be open at least one (1) hour prior to the first starting time each day of the Championship. Range balls will be provided for you before play each day courtesy of the MGA.

<u>DRESS CODE:</u> The Minnesota Golf Association dress code will be strictly enforced. **All players** and **caddies** must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. Jeans or jean shorts ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE! The Committee shall decide whether this requirement has been met.

**FOOTWEAR:** Chaska TC **prohibits** the use of shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes. All participants must honor this policy during the competition. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**
