Local Rules and Information Sheet

RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the Rules of Golf, the MGA Rules Card, Notice to Competitors, Entry Blank and the following Local Rules. NOTE: Disregard any and all Local Rules printed on the local scorecard.

TEES: There are two sets of tees for this tournament. Play is from the **white** MGA tee markers for the championship flight and from the **red** MGA tee markers for players in all other flights.

FORMAT: 36 holes gross stroke play for Championship and other flights excluding the Master Division, which is 36 holes net stroke play. (The event may be shortened due to extenuating circumstances.)

POSTING OF SCORES: The MGA *will be* posting scores to GHIN for handicap purposes.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Boundaries are defined by white stakes, white lines and the course-side edge of the road (pavement) on the right side of the 3rd hole.

YELLOW PENALTY AREAS: Yellow Penalty Areas are *identified and/or defined* by yellow stakes and/or lines. "Drop Zones" have been added on holes #14 and #17. These may be used as an additional option under Rule 17 for a ball that lies in, or is known or virtually certain to lie in, the Yellow Penalty Area on those two holes.

RED PENALTY AREAS: Red Penalty Areas are *identified and/or defined* by red stakes and/or lines.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: In addition to any white lined areas, the following are ground under repair:

1. French Drains (with or without exposed stones) located in the "General Area" are Ground Under Repair. Relief is for the **lie** of ball only (not stance or area of intended swing).
2. Cultivated Flower Beds: Play is prohibited from all flower beds. They are considered Ground Under Repair and relief is mandatory.

OBSTRUCTIONS: The parking lot and club house are immovable obstructions as are all cart paths, whether artificially surfaced or not.
