NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

FORMAT: All players entered in the Championship will play a round of 18 holes stroke play on Sunday, June 1 and Monday, June 2. The Champion will be the player with the lowest total score, regardless of flight, for 36 holes. Any ties for the Overall Championship will be played off immediately, hole by hole, until the Champion is determined.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds may be scheduled by contacting the Victory Links Golf Shop at (763) 717-3240. Please identify yourself as an MGA Women's Mid-Amateur participant, and you will receive the Patron Card rate in effect for the day and time you play.

PRACTICE RANGE: The practice range will be open at least one hour before play both days of the tournament. Range balls will be provided for you before play each day.

STARTING TIMES: There will be no change in starting times other than by decision of the Committee due to weather conditions. First round times will be 12:30-2:30 Sunday afternoon; second round times will be 7:30-9:30 Monday morning.

HOLE #1 TEE: Please note the first (1st) tee is a significant walk (5-6 minutes) from the clubhouse. Please plan accordingly.

DRESS CODE: The Minnesota Golf Association dress code will be strictly enforced. All players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. Players must wear appropriate golf attire including slacks, Capri pants, or Bermuda shorts measuring no higher than two inches above the knees. Jeans, jean shorts, short shorts, and tank tops ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE! The Committee shall decide whether this requirement has been met.

FOOTWEAR: Victory Links **prohibits** the use of shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION**

CADDIES AND CARTS: Victory Links **will not** have caddies available. You may bring your own caddie if you wish to do so. The use of motorized riding carts is **PERMITTED** during the Championship as is carrying your own bag and the use of pull-carts (including motorized). Carts are at the expense of the player. No more than two carts per group.

LOCAL RULES & PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Rules of Play and Pace of Play Policy will be in effect and strictly enforced. The Pace of Play is posted on the MGA Women's Mid-Amateur page of the MGA web site.

LODGING: No lodging arrangements have been made; however, there are a number of hotels within a reasonable distance.

PLAYERS' LUNCHEON: After play on Monday, the MGA will be hosting a Players' awards luncheon. Guests are welcome to attend for \$30/person (includes two drink tickets). Advance reservations are required; please RSVP to Doug Hoffmann, doug@mngolf.org.

COURSE SET-UP INFORMATION: The chart shows the anticipated course set-up and expected Pace of Play, although the Committee reserves the right to modify the set-up prior to the beginning of play. (NOTE: This is a change from what was originally published on the website.)
