## **Notice to Competitors**

<u>Qualifiers and Playoffs:</u> The low <u>2 Boys</u> scores and the low <u>4 Girls</u> scores from <u>Monticello</u> Country Club qualify for the Championship. In the event of a tie for the final qualifying place or either alternate position, a hole-by-hole playoff will be held immediately following the completion of play.

<u>Practice Rounds:</u> Monticello Country Club is a private golf facility. They have set aside a block of tee times for practice rounds. Other times may be available on a case by case basis. Please call the Monticello Golf Shop at 763-295-4653 and identify yourself as a USGA Junior Amateur Golfer to coordinate a tee time.

<u>Distance Measuring Devices:</u> Distance measuring devices are **NOT** allowed during any phase of the Championship. Penalty for breach of this condition = **DISQUALIFICATION**.

**Footwear Policy:** As stated on the official entry form, *shoes with traditionally-designed spikes* (regardless of composition) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are prohibited. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.** 

**Practice Range:** The practice range will be open one (1) hour before the first starting time on the morning of the qualifying. Range Balls may be purchased from the golf shop.

<u>Food and Beverage:</u> Food and Beverages will be available in the clubhouse or the concessions cart on the course.

**Starting Times:** There will be no change in the starting times established by the Committee other than by decision of the Committee due to weather conditions.

<u>Dress Code:</u> Shirts must have collars; <u>denim pants and jeans are not allowed</u>. Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. The Committee will decide whether this requirement has been met. Dress code applies to caddies as well as players. Players will be held responsible for appearance of caddies.

<u>Caddies and Carts:</u> There will not be caddies available during this qualifying. You may bring your own caddie if you wish to use one, or you may carry your own bag or use a non-motorized walking cart. The use of motorized carts is prohibited during all phases of the Championship. Spectators will not be allowed to rent carts. As stated in the official entry form, a player may not use a parent, step-parent, or guardian, as a caddie in any phase of the championship.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> The MGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect and the expected pace for this qualifying is posted on the MGA web site. You should make yourself familiar with it in advance

of the qualifying. In addition, a complete explanation guide may be found on the MGA web site – www.mngolf.org.

<u>Course Set-Up:</u> In order that you may play from the appropriate tees during a practice round, it is anticipated the golf courses will be set-up as listed below. However, the Committee reserves the right to alter this set-up.
