NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

FORMAT: All players entered in the Championship will play 36 holes stroke play over the two days Tuesday, September 10 and Wednesday, September 11. The Champion will be the player with the lowest total score for 36 holes, regardless of flight. A tie for the Overall Championship will be played off immediately, hole by hole, until the winner is determined. The field will be flighted according to handicap indices as of September 1.

RULES OF PLAY: All play is governed by the [Rules of Golf](#), the [MGA Terms of Competition](#), the [MGA Tournament Player's Information sheet](#), entry form and any Local Rules established and printed on the *Hole Location/Local Rules Sheet*.

REGISTRATION: There is no formal registration. Please be at your starting tee 10 minutes prior to your time.

ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES: These devices are *permitted* in all MGA championship competitions; however, any function that measures more than point-to-point are not permitted. Use of such function is the *General Penalty* for the first offense and *disqualification* for the second.

PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play Policy posted on the MGA web site and at the starting tee. Players are expected to know and abide by the posted policy.

STARTING TIMES: There will be no change in starting times other than by decision of the Committee due to weather conditions.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds are available for **\$60 walking** (cart \$27). Please call the respective Golf Shop and state you are an MGA Women's Mid-Amateur contestant.

PRACTICING BETWEEN ROUNDS (Model Local Rule I-1): Rule 5.2a is modified in this way: A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds. Thus, after finishing your first round, you may NOT go and play the other course prior to the second round.

PRACTICE RANGE: The practice range at both clubs will be open at least one hour prior to the first starting time each day of the Championship. Range balls will be provided for you before play each day courtesy of the MGA.

POSTING OF SCORES: All scores from the competitions will be entered into GHIN and identified as a tournament ("T") score by the MGA. Please DO NOT enter these scores yourself.

PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded to the Champion and first place finishers in each flight for their permanent possession. Merchandise prizes will be awarded as determined by the Tournament Committee.

CADDIES AND CARTS: Bearpath will not have caddies available. You may bring your own caddie if you wish to do so. Carrying your own bag is permissible as is the use of pull-carts, including motorized pull carts. **The use of motorized riding carts is prohibited during the tournament.**

DRESS CODE: The Minnesota Golf Association dress code will be strictly enforced. All players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. Players must wear appropriate golf attire including slacks, Capri pants, or Bermuda shorts measuring no higher than two inches above the knees. Jeans, jean shorts, and tank tops are not acceptable. The Committee shall decide whether this requirement has been met.

FOOTWEAR: Bearpath Golf & Country Club **prohibits** the use of shoes with metal or traditionally designed spikes. All participants must honor this policy during the competition. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**
