**NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

**FORMAT:** The Championship Flight will play 36 holes, gross stroke play. The Champions will be the team with the lowest gross score. Champions will receive trophies. The top 3 teams will receive golf shop credit.

**PLAY-OFF/DECISION ON TIES:** A hole-by-hole playoff will be held for the Championship flight (holes will be determined by the Committee).

**CHAMPIONSHIP PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Practice rounds are available for \$69 (walking; cart is \$25 per person). To schedule a practice round, call the LeSueur Golf Shop (507-665-6293) and identify yourself as an MGA Women's Four-Ball contestant.

**LODGING INFORMATION:** No specific lodging arrangements have been made.

**COURSE SETUP:** Specific course setup information is printed below.

**TEE MARKERS:** Due to numbers, there is only the championship flight for this tournament. Play will be from the GREEN MGA tee markers for this tournament.

**YARDAGE MARKERS:** Discs in the center of the fairway at 100 yards (red), 150 yards (white) and 200 yards (blue) from the middle of the green. Most sprinkler heads are marked.

**PRACTICE FACILITIES:** The practice range will be open at least 60 minutes prior to the first starting time each day of the Championship (weather permitting), and range balls are provided free of charge prior to play.

**HOLE LOCATIONS:** Refer to the hole location sheet.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Fences, white stakes and white lines.

**RED PENALTY AREAS:** Red Penalty Areas are identified by red stakes and defined by red lines. Yellow Penalty Areas are identified by yellow stakes and defined by yellow lines. A "Dropping Zone" has been established on the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole and the 9<sup>th</sup> hole. The "DZ" may be used as an additional option under Rule 17 for a ball that is in, or know or virtually certain to be in, the Penalty Area.

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** White lined areas. Refer to Rule 16 for relief options.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:** The rocks to the right of the cart path on hole 17 are considered part of the cart path. All cart paths that are artificial surfaced or dirt are considered obstructions. The small building in the right rough on hole 9 is an obstruction. Relief is for interference with the player's stance, lie of ball or area of intended swing. No relief if the only interference is on the line of play.

**REST AREAS:** 5<sup>th</sup> tee, 8<sup>th</sup> green, 12<sup>th</sup> tee and 14<sup>th</sup> tee.

**DRESS CODE:** As stated in the official entry form, the MGA dress code will be enforced. **The dress code will apply to caddies as well.** The player is responsible for the dress and actions of their caddie.

**CADDIES AND CART:** Caddies are permitted in MGA events. Contestants may carry their own bag or use a pull cart (including motorized). The use of a golf cart is permitted for this event. Carts may be prepaid online at the time of registration. If not prepaid, the fee may be paid on-site each day of the tournament.

**FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICE:** The Club will be open on Monday at 11:00 a.m. for food and beverage service before your round as well as after your round. We hope you will take advantage of this opportunity and show your support for the Club by enjoying their service!

**AWARDS LUNCH:** The MGA will provide lunch on Tuesday following play for all teams making the cut. Players will be able to order directly off the menu in the clubhouse. Awards will be presented upon the completion of play. A list of the results with gift certificate amounts will be provided to the Golf Shop shortly after play has concluded.

**DIGITAL SCORING:** All scoring will be done digitally using the *Golf Genius* app. Each team will be responsible for keeping scores in this manner. Teams should report to the scoring area upon completion of play to confirm the scores entered in the system. Scores may not be changed once teams leave the scoring area. Teams failing to report to the Scoring Area will have their scores declared as official after the 2<sup>nd</sup> group behind them completes play.

**RULE 23 – FOUR-BALL:** According to Rule 23.2b(1), hole scores recorded on the team’s Official Digital Scorecard MUST be assigned to the player who actually made the score. Failure to do so will result in either (a) being forced to take a higher score or (b) DISQUALIFICATION should the score be lower than the person’s correct score for that hole.

**FINAL ROUND STARTING TIMES:** Final round play will start from the 1<sup>st</sup> tee at approximately 7:00 a.m., with the leaders starting at 8:00 a.m. The MGA will send out emails and text messages with your starting time.

**PACE OF PLAY:** The posted Pace of Play Policy will be in effect.

**POSTING OF TOURNAMENT SCORES:** Tournament scores *will not* be posted for handicapping purposes.
