Notice to Competitors – Sectional Qualifying

FACILITIES: The Golf Shop, Clubhouse, and Practice Areas (if any) will be open at least 45 minutes prior to the first starting time. Practice areas may be limited; check with host facility as to availability and location.

DIRECTIONS: You should verify directions to your qualifying site and plan for delays due to construction, traffic, etc.

DRESS CODE: The dress code of the MGA is in effect for the Qualifying rounds. Please refer to the *Tournament Player's Information* section found on the MGA web site – <u>www.mngolf.org</u>.

ELECTRONIC MEASURING DEVICES: *Effective as of 2010,* the use of these stand-alone devices that measure distance only is permitted in MGA championships and qualifiers. Smart-phone distance measuring applications are not permitted. Penalty: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

FOOTWEAR POLICY: Traditionally designed or metal spikes are <u>prohibited</u> at all qualifying sites. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

CHECK IN: Please check in at your assigned tee 10 minutes prior to your starting time.

CADDIES/CARTS: Caddies are not available at any qualifying course. You may carry your own bag, use a pull cart, or bring your own caddie for the purpose of the Qualifying rounds. However, motorized carts are prohibited during all phases of the Championship.

PLAYOFFS: In the event of a tie for the final qualifying spot and/or any alternate position, a hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted at the site immediately following play.

QUALIFIERS' INFORMATION: Immediately following the conclusion of play, all successful qualifiers will be given information outlining the Championship proper.

ETIQUETTE: We are the guests of each host facility during the qualifying events. Please show proper etiquette and courtesy to the facility as well as your fellow competitors by replacing divots, fixing ball marks, and raking bunkers.

MGA RULES CARD & PACE OF PLAY: By submitting an application, you acknowledge the MGA Rules Card and the MGA Pace of Play policy govern play. The Pace of Play specific to your qualifying site as well as the MGA Rules Card may be found at the MGA web site, <u>www.mngolf.org</u>. You are expected to know and abide by them. A Local Rules Sheet will be distributed at starting.
