Notice to Competitors – Sectional Qualifying

FACILITIES: The Golf Shop and Practice Areas (if any) will be open at 40 minutes prior to the first starting time. Time in the practice areas are limited for each competitor as follows: Range – 20 minutes, Short Game Area/Putting Green – 15 minutes. If you arrive more than 40 minutes prior to your starting time, please stay in the parking lot until you are scheduled to be in a practice area. Check with host facility as to availability and location of practice areas. Exceptions may be made depending on the size of the practice areas.

Use of the practice facilities after play is **permitted** if you may be in a playoff.

DIRECTIONS: You should verify directions to your qualifying site and plan for delays due to construction, traffic, etc.

DRESS CODE: The dress code of the MGA is in effect for the Qualifying rounds. Please refer to the *Tournament Player's Information* section found on the MGA web site – www.mngolf.org.

FOOTWEAR POLICY: Traditionally designed or metal spikes are **prohibited** at all qualifying sites. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION**.

ETIQUETTE: The MGA and all players are guests of the respective host facilities during all championship and qualifying events. Please show proper respect, etiquette and courtesy to the facility as well as the other players by replacing divots, fixing ball marks and smoothing bunkers.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Please contact your qualifying course for practice round information.

RULES OF PLAY: By submitting an application, you acknowledge the **COVID-19 Special Local Rules, Rules of Golf, MGA Terms of Competition** and any other **Local Rules** govern play. The **Terms of Competition** may be found on the MGA website. The **Local Rules** and **Course Setup** are available on the webpage of the appropriate championship.

MGA PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play Policy for 2020 is in effect for all qualifiers. The policy specific to each qualifying site has been posted on the Championship home page. It is suggested players carry a watch in order to check the pace in relation to the policy.

CHECK IN: Please check in at your assigned tee immediately after the group in front of you has left the teeing area.

CADDIES/CARTS: Caddies ARE NOT PERMITTED during the qualifying process.

--**For Players' & Mid-Players' Qualifiers:** You may carry your own bag or use a pull/push cart (including motorized). However, motorized riding carts are prohibited during all stages of the Championship.

--**For Senior Players' Qualifiers:** You may carry your own bag or use a pull/push cart (including motorized). Motorized riding carts ARE permitted during ALL stages of the Championship.

--**NOTE:** Players attempting to qualify for the Senior AND either of the other championships WILL NOT be permitted to use a motorized riding cart.

PLAYOFFS: In the event of a tie for the final qualifying spot and/or any alternate positions, a hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted at the site immediately following play.

QUALIFIERS' INFORMATION: All successful qualifiers will be given information outlining the Championship proper. There will be a \$55 Championship fee for all successful qualifiers.

DRINKING WATER: Drinking water will not be provided on the course but may be available from the clubhouse. Players should make plans to bring their own water.
