### Notice to Competitors – Sectional Qualifying

**FACILITIES:** The Golf Shop and Practice Areas (if any) will be open at 60 minutes prior to the first starting time. Practice areas may be limited, check with host facility as to availability and location.

**DIRECTIONS:** You should verify directions to your qualifying site and plan for delays due to construction, traffic, etc.

**DRESS CODE:** The dress code of the MGA is in effect for the Qualifying rounds. Please refer to the *Tournaments FAQ* on the MGA web site – [www.mngolf.org](http://www.mngolf.org) dropdown under TOURNAMENTS → All Tournaments → bottom of page for FAQ.

**FOOTWEAR POLICY:** Traditionally designed or metal spikes are **prohibited** at all qualifying sites. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION**.

**ETIQUETTE:** The MGA and all players are guests of the respective host facilities during all championship and qualifying events. Please show proper respect, etiquette, and courtesy to the facility and other players by replacing divots, fixing ball marks, and smoothing bunkers.

**PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Please contact your qualifying course for practice round information.

**CHECK IN:** When you arrive at the course, please look for a registration table and please check in at your assigned tee immediately after the group in front of you has left the teeing area.

**RULES OF PLAY:** By applying, you acknowledge the *Tournament Policies and Procedures, Rules of Golf, MGA Terms of Competition* and any other *Local Rules* govern play. The *Terms of Competition* may be found on the MGA website. The *Local Rules* and *Course Setup* are available on the webpage of the appropriate championship.

**MGA PACE OF PLAY:** The MGA Pace of Play Policy for 2024 is in effect for all qualifiers. The policy specific to each qualifying site has been posted on the Championship Qualifier home page. It is suggested players carry a device to check the pace in relation to the policy.

**CADDIES/CARTS:** Players are permitted to use caddies.

**--For Players' & Mid-Players' Qualifiers:** You may carry your own bag or use a pull/push cart (including motorized). However, motorized riding carts are prohibited during all stages of the Championship (an exception may be made during Pool Play in the Mid-Players' Championship).

**--For Senior Players' Qualifiers:** You may carry your own bag or use a pull/push cart (including motorized). Motorized riding carts ARE permitted during ALL stages of the Championship.

**--NOTE:** Players attempting to qualify for the Senior AND either of the other championships WILL NOT be permitted to use a motorized riding cart.

**PLAYOFFS:** In the event of a tie for the final qualifying spot and/or any alternate positions, a hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted at the site immediately following play. **NOTE:** Motorized riding carts MAY be used in the event of a playoff at the discretion of the Committee.

**QUALIFIERS' INFORMATION:** All successful qualifiers will be sent information outlining the Championship proper. There will be a \$80 Championship fee for all successful qualifiers in the Players' Championship and \$125 in the Mid-Players' and Senior Players' Championships.

**DRINKING WATER:** Drinking water will not be provided on the course but may be available from the clubhouse. Players should make plans to bring their own water.
