Notice to Competitors – Qualifying

FACILITIES: The Golf Shop and Practice Areas (if any) will be open 60 minutes prior to the first starting time. Practice areas may be limited; check with host facility as to availability and location.

DIRECTIONS: You should verify directions to your qualifying site and plan for delays due to construction, traffic, etc.

DRESS CODE: The dress code of the MGA is in effect for the Qualifying rounds. Please refer to the *Tournament Player's Information* section found on the MGA web site – <u>www.mngolf.org</u>.

FOOTWEAR POLICY: Traditionally designed or metal spikes are **<u>prohibited</u>** at all qualifying sites. Penalty for breach of this condition: **DISQUALIFICATION.**

ETIQUETTE: The MGA and all players are guests of the respective host facilities during all championship and qualifying events. Please show proper respect, etiquette and courtesy to the facility as well as the other players by replacing divots, fixing ball marks and smoothing bunkers.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Please contact your qualifying course for practice round information.

CHECK IN: In the absence of a registration table, please check in at your assigned tee 10 minutes prior to your starting time. Please arrive, immediately after the group in front of you has left the teeing area. A registration table will be set up near the parking lot or inside the clubhouse at all metro qualifiers.

RULES OF PLAY: By submitting an application, you acknowledge the *Rules of Golf, Model Local Rules, MGA Terms of Competition* and any *Local Rules* govern play. The *Terms of Competition* may be found on the MGA website. The *Local Rules* is available on the <u>MGA Senior Amateur Landing Page</u>. A paper copy will be available at the starting tee to allow you to take a photo of the document. Hole location sheets will not be produced for qualifiers.

MGA PACE OF PLAY: The MGA Pace of Play Policy for 2024 is in effect for all qualifiers. The policy specific to each qualifying site has been posted on the qualifier home page. It is suggested players carry a device in order to check the pace in relation to the policy.

CADDIES/CARTS: Players are permitted to use caddies. You may carry your own bag, use a pull cart (manual or motorized). Motorized riding carts are an additional option.

DRINKING WATER: Drinking water will not be provided on the course but may be available from the clubhouse. Players should make plans to bring their own water.

SPECTATORS: Spectators are allowed on the golf course. Spectators should follow the appropriate dress code and etiquette guidelines. Spectator Carts are available with a handicap placard at an additional cost.

PLAYOFFS: In the event of a tie for the final qualifying spot, a hole-by-hole playoff will be conducted at the site immediately following play. Please check your cell number in your Golf Genius Profile prior to starting play.

ALTERNATES: We will follow the Alternate Policy found on the event website landing page.
