MGA WOMEN'S MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

Dahlgreen Golf Club, Chaska, MN Monday-Wednesday, June 24-26, 2019

GENERAL INFORMATION

Eligibility

Entries are open to female amateur golfers who are: (1) currently Associate Members of the MGA at the club from which they are playing, and (2) whose club is a current member club of the MGA. All entries are subject to approval or rejection at any time by the MGA Tournament Committee.

Championship Format

There will be two divisions for play: **OPEN** and **SENIOR**. The Senior Division is open to players who are at least 50 years old as of the first day of the Championship. A player eligible for the Senior Division may elect to play in the Open Division. If no division is selected at the time of entry, a player will be assigned to the division according to her age. Qualifying round will be 18 holes, stroke play. All other play will be 18 holes, match play.

Open Division: Open division participants will play a qualifying round in the morning of Day 1 to determine the flights for the remainder of the Championship. The Defending Champion and the top 15 qualifiers will compete in the Championship Flight. The remaining players will be placed in flights of 8 based on qualifying score. Ties for the last spot in the Championship Flight will be played off, hole-by-hole, until a winner is determined. Ties for all other flights will be determined by matching qualifying scorecards following the USGA recommendations. The Defending Champion will be the #1 seed. All other seeding will be based on the qualifying scores. All flights will play first round matches in the afternoon of Day 1. On Day 2, all players advancing to Round 2 will play matches in the morning. The Championship flight will play semi-final matches in the afternoon. On Day 3, all flights will play Championship matches. There will be no consolation flights in the Open Division. In the open division only, If the field is oversubscribed or incomplete, (not divisible by flights of eight), entries will be accepted to complete full flights based on the order they have signed up. Players will be placed on an alternate list until a flight is complete. In case openings occur in the last flight due to withdrawals prior to the pairings being released, applicants will be placed on the alternate list.

<u>Senior Division</u>: Senior division participants will be placed in flights of 8, with the Defending Champion seeded #1 in the Championship Flight, according to handicap index as of the revision of June 1 and will play one match per day as follows: Day 1 – Afternoon, Days 2 & 3 – Morning. The Senior Division will have consolation flights after Round 1 and no qualifying round.

Dress Code

For all MGA competitions, players and caddies must be neat in appearance with respect to personal grooming and clothing. All entrants are required to wear appropriate golf attire as defined by the host club and/or the MGA. Short shorts, athletic shorts, tennis shorts, denim, tank tops, T-shirts and sweats are not acceptable. The committee will decide whether this requirement has been met and will withdraw the entry of any player not complying.

Code of Conduct Policy

The MGA Conduct Policy will be strictly enforced at the Championship. It may be viewed online in the Tournament Section of the MGA website.

Entry Deadline

Players are encouraged to enter MGA events online through the MGA website – www.mngolf.org. Entries will not be accepted before 8:30 am Monday, March 19, 2018, but must arrive no later than Monday, June 11, 2018, at the office of the innesota Golf Association, Inc., 6550 York Avenue South, Suite 211, Edina, MN 55435. Entry fee must accompany entry form. A separate check or money order must accompany each MGA championship entry. Late or incomplete entries are not acceptable and will be returned. Entries submitted by telephone, e-mail or fax are not acceptable. Time limit for entries means time of receipt at MGA (not time of postmark). Entries with insufficient funds will be considered incomplete and will be withdrawn. The entrant is responsible for any fee incurred by the MGA for NSF checks and must pay such fees before entry in further MGA events is allowed.

Carts and Caddies

Carrying your bag, the use of a pull cart (including motorized) and motorized riding carts are permitted. Motorized riding carts are **prohibited in the Championship Matches**, but are permitted in the Flights Division and during qualifying. Only motorized carts provided by the host facility may be used. Contestants are responsible for paying the appropriate fee for the use of such carts prior to play each day. Faribault GC will not have caddies available. You are encouraged to bring your own caddie, if desired.

Practice Rounds

Practice rounds may be available for a fee at the discretion of the Host Facility.
